It operates six regional cancer centres in Surrey, Kelowna, Vancouver, Victoria, Abbotsford, and Prince George, along with two research centres that conduct research into the causes and cures for cancer.

An opportunity exists for an 8-month locum from May 8 to December 29, 2017 at the Vancouver Island Centre (VIC). The Radiation Oncology Department at this centre has a complement of eighteen Radiation Oncologists and one General Practitioner in Oncology, working within a provincial Radiation Therapy program. VIC has 6 TruBeam linear accelerators and has 2 large bore multi-slice CT simulators. VIC has active practices in CNS and lung stereotactic radiotherapy and gynecologic and prostate brachytherapy. Teaching opportunities are abundant at VIC as medical students, residents, and fellows train at VIC.

The BCCA has a well developed system of provincial tumor groups, centralized data collection and protocol development, supported by collegiality and ready access to videoconferencing between centres that has placed BCCA teams at the forefront of innovation and outcomes evaluation in many areas.

The successful applicant will be expected to deliver excellent patient care and be involved in teaching of medical students and residents and in research and innovation.

Victoria, "The City of Gardens", is one of Canada's most beautiful cities and offers the country's most temperate year-round climate. Vancouver Island is known for its spectacular Pacific Ocean beaches, ski hills, sailing, hiking and fishing.
